Is a non-profit community-based agency that offers professional counselling and support services to children, teenagers, adults, couples and families. The Centre also provides employers with education and consulting services for their employees.



Our Community Programs

General Counselling

- Assistance in dealing with a broad range of personal, relationship, and/or social problems;
- Funding is provided through fundraising and clients' fees.

Violence Against Women

- Counselling for women who are or have been in an abusive relationship;
- Counselling for children who have been exposed to violence against their mother;
- Services are FREE; funded by the Ontario Ministry of Community and Social Services.

Partner Assault Response

- Group for men or women who are charged with domestic violence and mandated to attend the group;
- Partner contacts services are offered in collaboration or as a parallel service;
- Funded by client fees and the Ministry Attorney General.

Back on Track

- For persons that have been charged for operating a vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or other drugs/medication and who are required by courts to participate in the program;
- Funding for this program is provided by client fees and the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health, in partnership with the Government of Ontario.

Child Witness Program

- Impartial support to victims/witnesses 17 years of age and under, who are required to provide testimony in court, as well to their parents or guardians;
- Services are funded by the Government of Ontario.

Male Survivors of Sexual Abuse

- Supportive services, including individual and group counselling, peer support, and telephone counselling;
- Services are funded by the Government of Ontario.

Our Corporate Program

Employee Assistance Program (EAP)

- Counselling, support education and therapeutic group for employees and their families;
- Organizational health services for companies and agencies

Substance Abuse Program (SAP)

 Client centered supporting employees and their families to address/improve work, health and life challenges.

Funding for these programs is provided by employers who have an agreement with our agency.
